SHARED PROSPERITY

- The farm will provide affordable **mechanization services** to smallholder farmers on **592 acres**
- The farm will provide water and affordable food to over **10,200 community members annually**
- **3,000 farmers** will be **trained annually** in sustainable agriculture



RESILIENCE / LAUDATO SI'

- **10,000 trees** will be planted annually.
- The farm will expand **organic farming** from **15 acres to 65 acres**
- The farm will expand acreage under irrigation from **2 acres to 50 acres**
- Crop rotation program to maintain soil fertility and reduce use of chemicals



STRENGTHENED SOCIAL ENTITIES

- Income will support Parish's health facility serving over **7,800 patients** annually and **23 schools** educating over **10,300 students**
- Surplus income will also support the **diocese's 15 health facilities** serving over **1.2 million patients** annually and **868 schools** serving over **330,000 students**
