## IMPACT



### SHARED PROSPERITY

- The hospital will employ **115 full time employees, 15 casual laborers and 5 community health care workers**
- The hospital will provide free care to **500 people** per year in remote communities



### RESILIENCE / LAUDATO SI'

- The hospital has contracted a nationally accredited waste management company to collect and properly dispose of hospital waste
- The hospital supplements energy usage with solar panels to reduce reliance on fossil fuels



### STRENGTHENED SOCIAL ENTITIES

- The loan will enable the hospital to provide expanded maternity care for patients with complex cases to improve outcomes in a country which accounts for **20%** of global maternity deaths
- The hospital serves a population of 3.5 million people and expects to care for 150,000 patients annually after the loan



### MISSIO INVEST ADVISORY & SUPPORT

- Missio Invest will provide technical assistance to support the hospital's record keeping
- Missio Invest's healthcare consultants will support the hospital in training of staff, procurement of equipment, and construction in accordance with local regulations
