### INVESTMENT HIGHLIGHTS

- Confirmed available market due to increased demand for pork among growing population
- The piggery will increase the Archdiocese's financial sustainability, providing support for its social service institutions
- The farm is easily accessible with proximity to the market
- The piggery will stimulate economic activity by buying produce for feeds from smallholder farmers
- The project will create employment opportunities during and after implementation
- The Archdiocese has adequate arable land which can be used to scale up the project

## IMPACT



### SHARED PROSPERITY

- **10 full time jobs** to be created post investment
- **20 casual laborers** expected during construction of the piggeries
- The farm will buy feed produce from **100 smallholder farmers**



### RESILIENCE / LAUDATO SI'

- The farm will use solar energy for water pumping and backup lighting
- The Archdiocese plans to provide water for domestic use to **14 households** per annum
- The archdiocese is currently planting **5 trees** per year and expects to increase this to **10 trees per year**



### FOOD SECURITY

- The Archdiocese plans to start providing food to **15 households** per year



### STRENGTHENED SOCIAL ENTITIES

- The Archdiocese **supports 9 hospitals, 7 health centers, and 3 schools** and is a proprietor in **415 schools**
