- The hostel will employ 5 full time employees and 2 casual laborers
- The hostel will provide safe and affordable student housing for 60 women and 40 men each year
- The hostel is conveniently located only 2km away from the KNUST campus, saving students money and freeing up more time for studying



RESILIENCE / LAUDATO SI'

 The hostel has made a provision to partner with a locally recognized waste collection firm to ensure proper disposal of solid waste



STRENGTHENED SOCIAL ENTITIES

- The hostel will provide water from its borehole to local members of the community
- Income from the hostel can support the diocese's healthcare institutions including
 4 hospitals, a healthcare center and 5 clinics, which together serve over 300,000 patients per year
