# SHARED PROSPERITY

- The farm will more than triple its fulltime staff as a result of the loan, expanding from six to 19 full-time employees
- The farm will more than double its casual labor workforce as a result of the loan, expanding from 38 to 85 causal laborers
- The farm expect to provide training for 3,000 smallholder farmers per year



# RESILIENCE / LAUDATO SI'

- The farm uses an integrated farming approach
- The farm uses hydroelectric power and plans to add solar power after the loan
- The farm plants 5,000 trees per year
- The farm expects to irrigate an additional 20 acres after the loan



# STRENGTHENED SOCIAL ENTITIES

- The farm will provide technical and financial assistance to 500 families
- The farm provides clean water to 40 households and provides food for 850 households
