- Education: Nursery to Secondary School

USE OF LOAN

- Construction of a new secondary school with dormitories and equipment for online learning

INVESTMENT HIGHLIGHTS

- The Dominican Congregation has been successfully running schools in DRC for **67 years**, owning **3 schools** and supervising **13 others** with the approval of the National Episcopal Conference of Congo
- The new facility will be the fourth school owned by the Congregation, accommodating up to **2,000 students** with a boarding facility with **200 rooms**
- **At least 40%** of the new student population will be female. The school will be equipped with an online education system to ensure course continuity during emergencies or unexpected events
- The Dominican Fathers' Superior General in Rome has endorsed the project and will sign a guaranty for the loan
- The new school will be overseen by a Board of Directors from the Congregation

IMPACT



SHARED PROSPERITY

- Post-investment, the staff count will increase to **246 full-time employees**, up from the current staff of **202 full-time employees**
- Post-loan, the total number of students trained will grow from **12,000 students to 14,000 students**.



RESILIENCE / LAUDATO SI'

- **100,000 trees** have been planted to date, and the Congregation will plant **15,000 fruit trees** post-investment investment



FOOD SECURITY

- The new boarding facility will provide meals to the residents daily
- The Congregation will continue to provide food assistance to needy families in the community



STRENGTHENED SOCIAL ENTITIES

- The Congregation operates a vocational training center that has supported **100 underprivileged young women** to date
- The communal center managed by the Congregation provides training services to **75 individuals with disabilities**
